The Rolet domain was established in the early 40s by Désiré Rolet. It is the second largest domain in the Jura region. This domain is 60 hectares and consists of three appellations: 36% Arbois, 21% Côtes du Jura and 43% L'étoile that contain five different grape varieties: Chardonnay, Savagnin, Poulsard, Trousseau and Pinot noir. The vineyards of the Jura are on clayey slopes, covered with marl and gravel.

Vinification

Light yellow color with golden hues. After years of evolution, this intense golden yellow color. Balanced in the nose, with aromas of nuts, dried fruit, almonds and herbs. In the mouth the dried fruit, roasted with an infinite finale. Wine of the oxidative type with many aromas.

Taste

Lichte, gele kleur met gouden tinten. Na jaren van evolutie wordt dit intens goudgeel van kleur. In de neus, evenwichtig, aroma van noten, gedroogd fruit, amandelen en kruiden. In de mond het gedroogde fruit, geroosterd met een oneindige finale. Wijn van het oxidatieve type met veel aroma's.
